The early 20th Century Response to the Prayer for Humility was inspired by the prophet Jeremiah. The late 20th Century Response to the Declaration is set to a folk melody. The mid 19th Century Introduction and Response to the First Pew was written in the Dakota language to fit the Dakota tune. The Sermon Hymn was commissioned for the centennial of the First Presbyterian Church of San Anselmo. The Sending Refrain describes the breadth of experiencing the Spirit of God.
