In keeping with our Matthew 25 Initiative foci on eradicating systemic poverty and mitigating climate change, Pastor Gusti is coordinating with the Presbyterian Office of Public Witness in Washington, DC to bring our concerns to Senator Capito on these issues, including a training on faith-based advocacy. Roughly 50 people have already signed up. Date and time are still under negotiation.
